A field trip to B.M Planetarium was organized by the Club on 18th March 2022. 99 students from the UG and PG classes of the Physics department along with 4 staff of Ethiraj College for Women were taken on a field trip. 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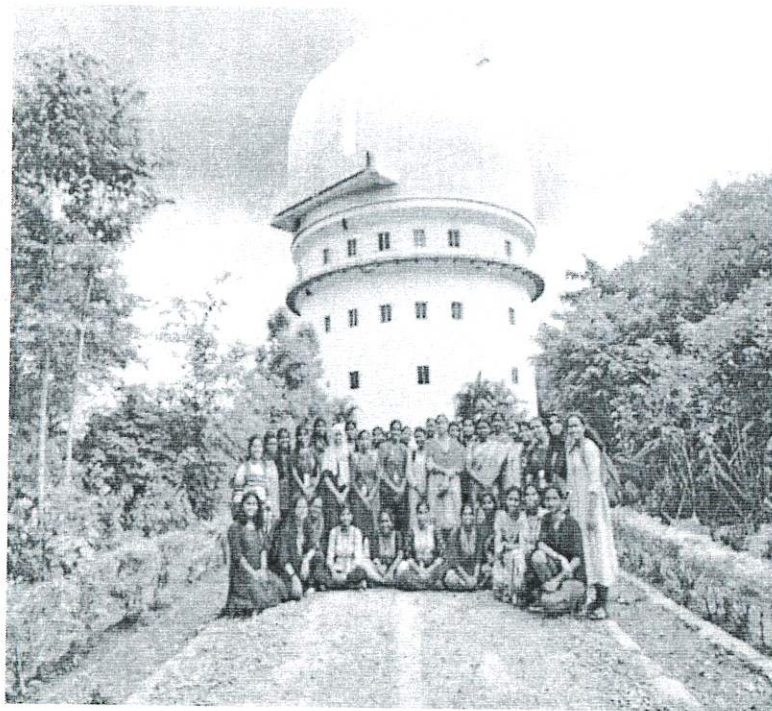
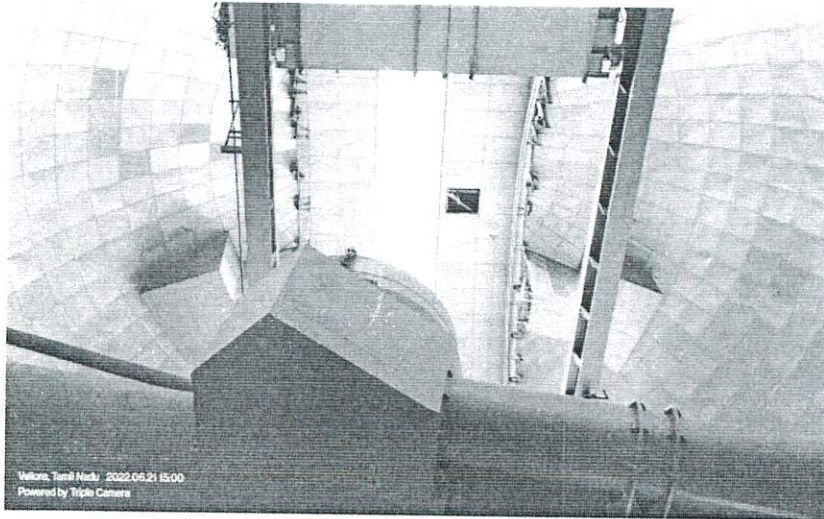
INDUSTRIAL VISIT TO VAINU BAPPO OBSERVATORY, KAVALUR

The 34 final year UG students of the Department of Physics along with the Faculties Dr. B. Uma and Dr. M. Amudha were taken on an Industrial Visit to VainuBappu Observatory, Kavalur on 21st June 2022. The students along with the staff members boarded the bus at 6:30 am from the college main campus. The journey towards the observatory took around 6 hours. Upon reaching the observatory, the students were taken to see the 90" telescope, the world's second largest telescope. The students were later taken inside to the top floor of the building where the telescope is mounted. The working and functioning of the telescope were explained to the students. Additionally, the dome of the telescope was opened for the students to see. The telescope was also rotated in order for the students to see how the telescope moves around inside the dome. The students also had the opportunity to interact and talk to the crew members working there. Images and observatory data collected by the 90" telescope was also shown. The observatory has five huge telescope and the students viewed all of these telescopes enroute. The lush greenery and chill climate were the added benefits of visiting the observatory. This industrial visit inculcated the wonders of astronomy and astrophysics in the minds of the students.

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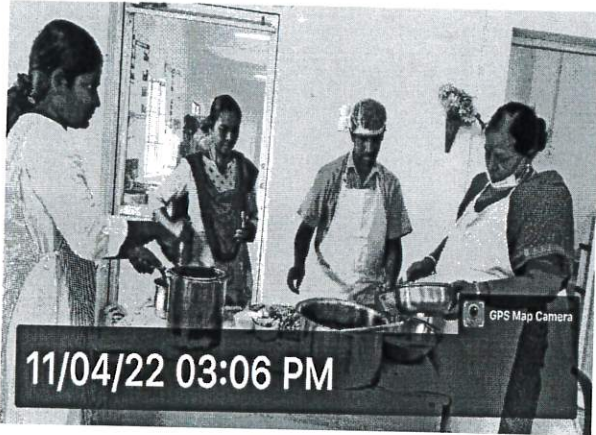

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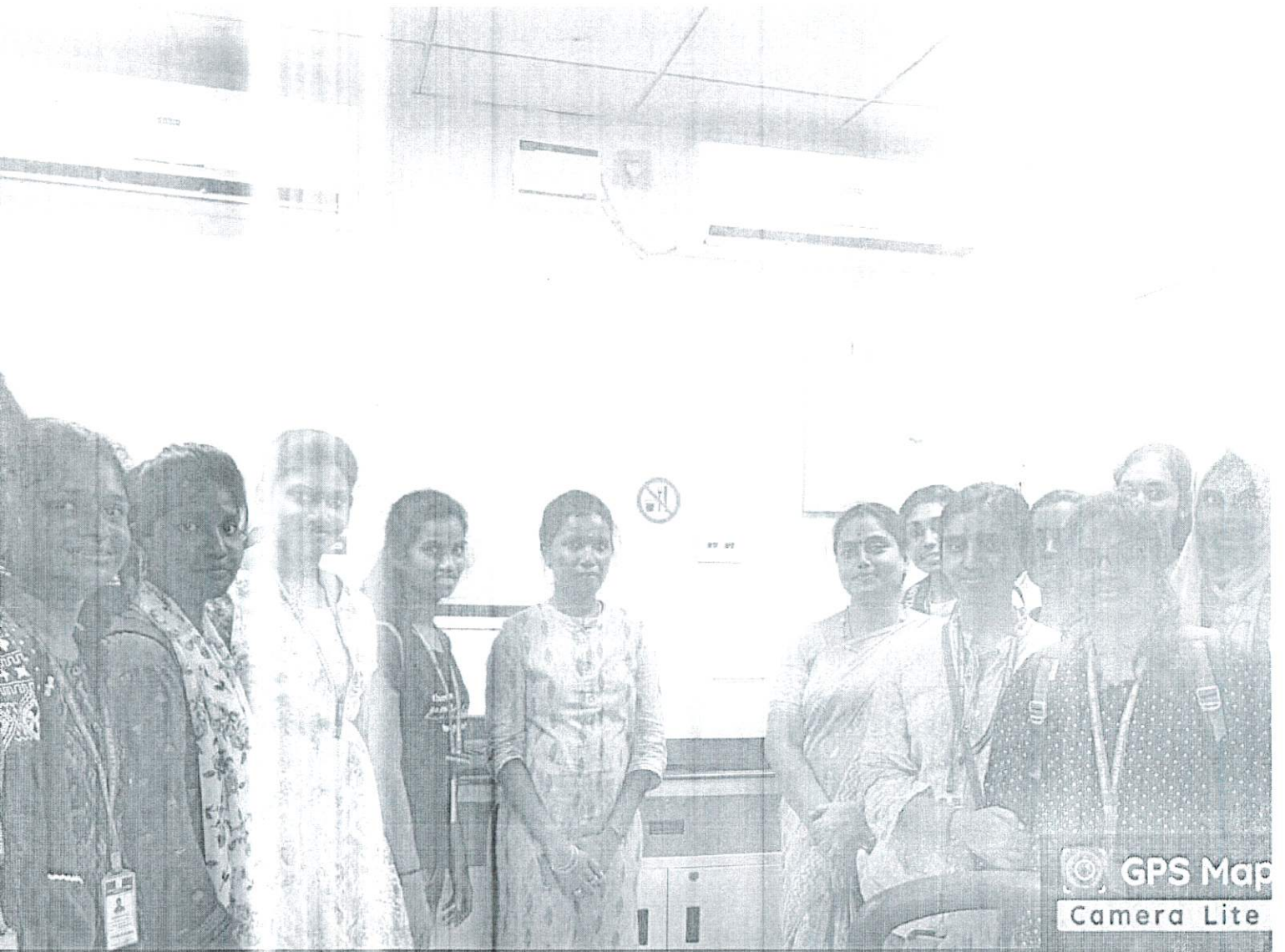


Industrial visit to the Golden Jubilee Women's Bio-Tech park , Siruseri
