Institutional heads orient the students on the expected student conduct that aligns with their respective portfolios.

- The Principal and Vice Principals welcome the students and staff to an enriching experience in Ethiraj College for Women. They address the gathering of students in terms of the Code of Conduct of the college and insist on the importance of maintaining the Code of Conduct as Ethirajians.
- The Controller of Examination addresses the students regarding the practices of the college regarding examinations elaborating on the importance of attendance records and ethical practices during the examinations.
- The Dean of Students informs the students about the constitution and responsibilities of the Students Union and encourages the students to participate in growth oriented and ethical activities on campus.
- The Dean of Research orients the fresh minds to instill a thirst for research enrichment along with academic progress. Emphasis on ethical practices of research is given to the gathering.
- The Dean of Academics prompts the students on their responsibilities within and outside the campus as students of Ethiraj College of Women. High emphasis would be given to orienting the students on their academic routines and academic behaviors encouraged by the college.

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Orientation Program (2021-22)

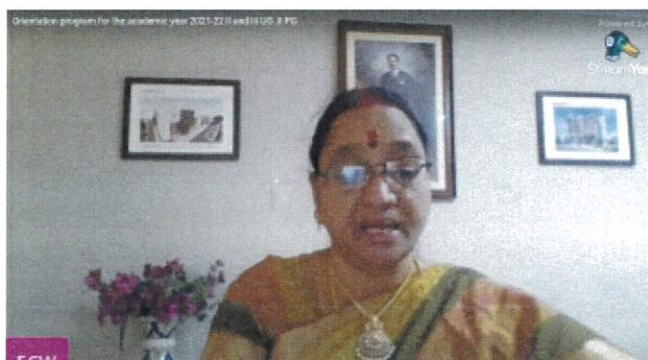
The orientation program for II & III UG and II PG students, was a five day event from 12th to 16th July 2021.

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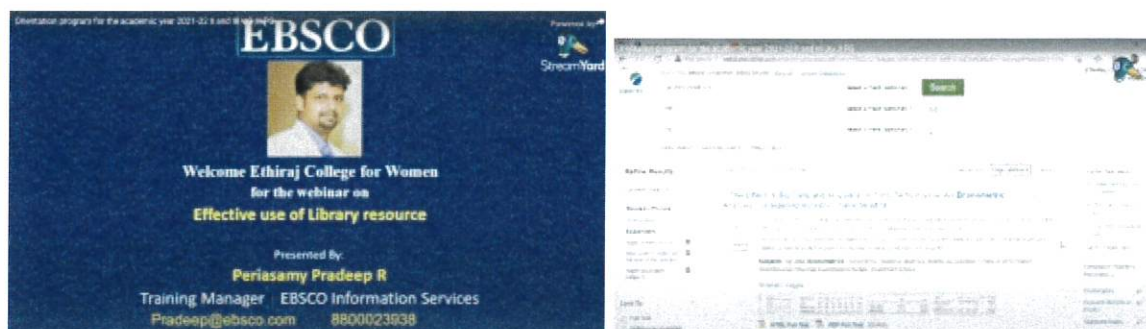
