The student strength of the college is 7520 for the Academic Year 2020-2021. The college has 490 computers for student use. These computers are shared by students of both the Aided and Self-Supporting Stream. The college timing for Aided Stream is 08.00 am – 01.30 pm and for Self-Supporting Stream is 11.30 am – 05.00 pm. There is optimum utilization of the computers for academic engagement through a well-planned time schedule. All the labs function from 08.00 am to 05.00 pm to facilitate the usage of computers by different classes throughout the week. This ensures that during lab hours **the actual Student-Computer ratio is 1:1**. The computers available in the library are used by the students for accessing e-resources. In addition, around 50 computers and 100 laptops are collaboratively used by both faculty and students to access the LMS and other ICT tools for teaching and learning.
