CONTROLLER OF EXAMINATIONS



The Office of the Controller of Examinations has been working towards excellence and transparency in the evaluation process of the college since the granting of Autonomy in 1999. During the current academic year, the office of the COE has been working with its customary dedication and sincerity in performing its mandated duties in an efficient and orderly manner.

The fully automated office, equipped with the relevant software and exam management system is enriched with a committed and dedicated staff force, that caters to the needs of the nearly 8000 members of the student body, and teachers. The Office is headed by the Controller of Examinations, Dr. R K Maya (Department of History, Tourism and Travel Management) and assisted by the Additional Controller of Examinations, Dr. Jeyanthi (Department of Bank Management) from the Self-Supporting stream.

The new academic year commenced with an

Orientation programme for the freshers wherein the then COE briefed the students on the examination pattern and the do's and don'ts to be observed during examinations. The next major responsibility was the conduction of the Academic Council Meeting on the 05th of December 2019 which saw the ratification of the Outcome-Based Education pattern of Syllabus passed by the various Boards of Study. Prior to the conduct of the End-Semester examinations, the faculty officiating as Hall Superintendents/Evaluators were addressed in the staff meeting and provided hand-outs about their role and responsibilities during the conduct of examinations.

The End Semester examinations were held in November 2019. The responsibility of the Conduction of the exams for the academic year was taken up by the Department of History, Tourism and Travel Management with Dr. T. Kausalya Kumari, as Chief Superintendent. The responsibility of conducting the Valuation Camp
