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

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


Student Feedback Analysis

i. 53.8% strongly agreed and 42.3% agreed (96.1%) of the students agreed that the course objectives and outcomes were well defined.




2.Extent of syllabi covered in the Class

















































It has been found that 40.3% of the students are satisfied that the electives offered are relevant to the specialization streams and to the technological advancements, 31.9% of the students are neither satisfied nor dissatisfied that the electives offered are relevant to the specialization streams and to the technological advancements, 22.2% of the students are highly satisfied that the electives offered are relevant to the specialization streams and to the technological advancements, 4.2% of the students are dissatisfied that the electives offered are relevant to the specialization streams and to the technological advancements and 1.4% of the students are highly



dissatisfied that the electives offered are relevant to the specialization streams and to the technological advancements.


