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Activities of the IQAC during the academic year 2020-21

Orientation Programme

The IQAC, in collaboration with the Department of Microbiology, organized a week-long Orientation programme in June. Feedback regarding the Orientation Programme and also about the speakers was collected from the students and analyzed by the IQAC.

SSR

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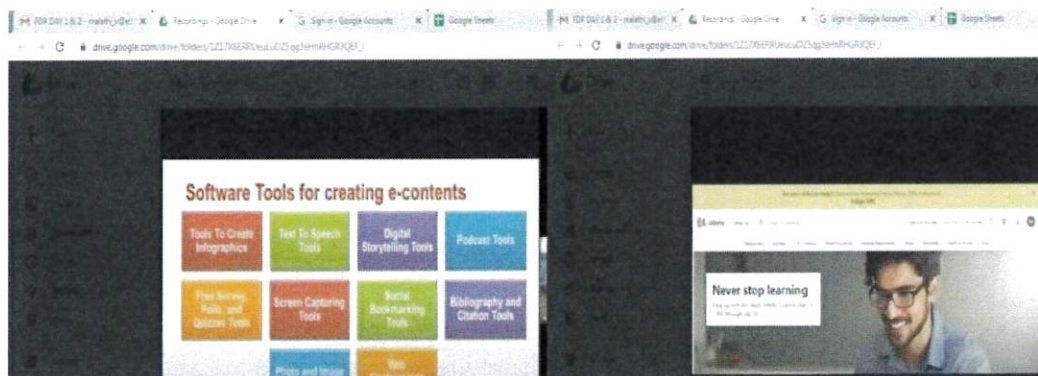
Resource Persons:

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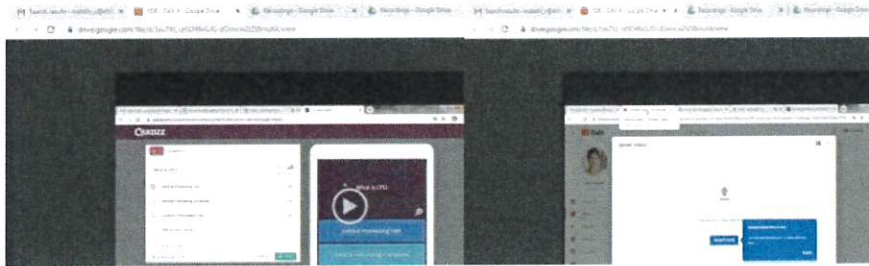
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Afternoon session

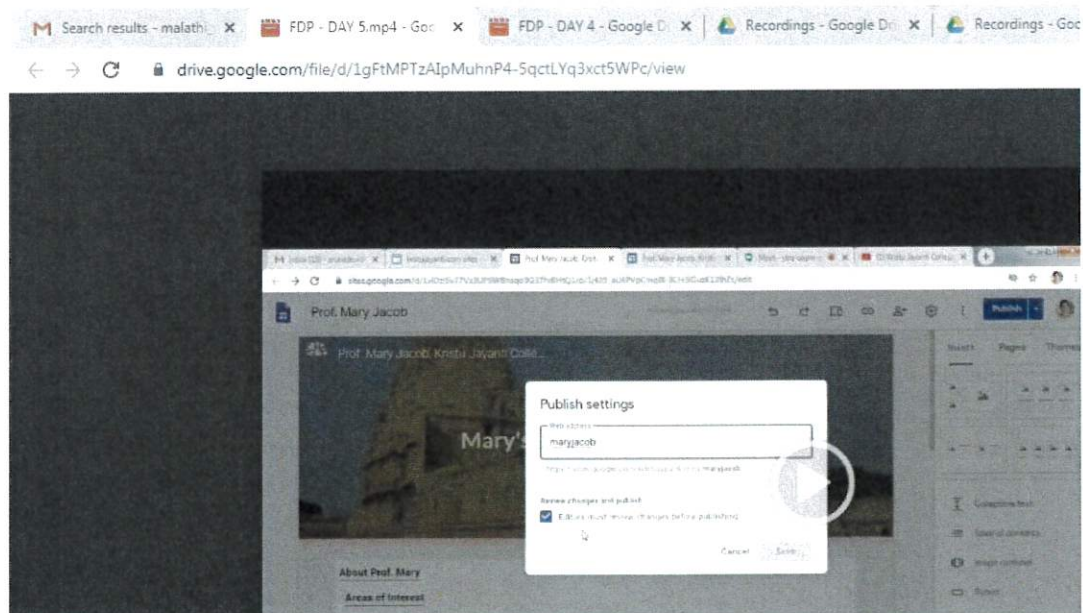
