**THE MINUTES OF BOARD OF STUDIES HELD IN THE
DEPARTMENT OF SANSKRIT ON 04/09/2019 AT 2.30 p.m.**

The Board had met with a resolve to approve and ratify the syllabi, Examination Pattern, rubrics of Evaluation to be followed by the U.G. students admitted from 2018-19 for Part I Sanskrit Foundation Course and Part IV Non Major Elective for U. G. Programme. The members of the Board were Dr. V. Anusha, the Chairperson, Dr. O.R. Devanathan, Head of the Department of Sanskrit and Vice Principal, Presidency College as the University Representative. The Subject Experts were Dr. K. Prasanth, Head, P. G. And Research Dept. Of Sanskrit, Vivekananda College, Mylapore and Dr. R. Subasri, Head, dept. Of Sanskrit, Stella Maris College. The other members of the Department - Ms. Gowri, Mrs. Sravana and alumni member Ms. R. The Changes made in the Syllabi are -

1. Catering to the current need in the academics to include outcomes and objectives in the course, the same have been included and placed for approval in the board of Studies.
2. The rubrics of Evaluation for the different components, the correlation tables of Course Outcomes and Knowledge Levels have been included.
3. The CA pattern is changed to facilitate students to attend the end semester question paper.
4. The Paper Pattern of Non Major Elective is changed to suit the course
5. The End Semester Question paper Pattern was rewritten by incorporating Bloom's taxonomy
6. The Panel of Examiners was also approved by the Board
