**Date: 13th October 2020**

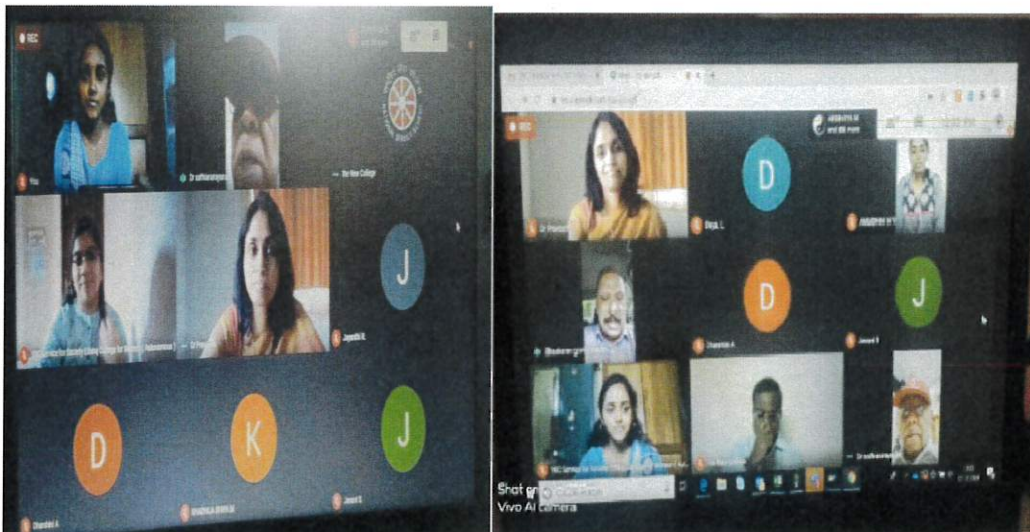
**Number of students: 200**

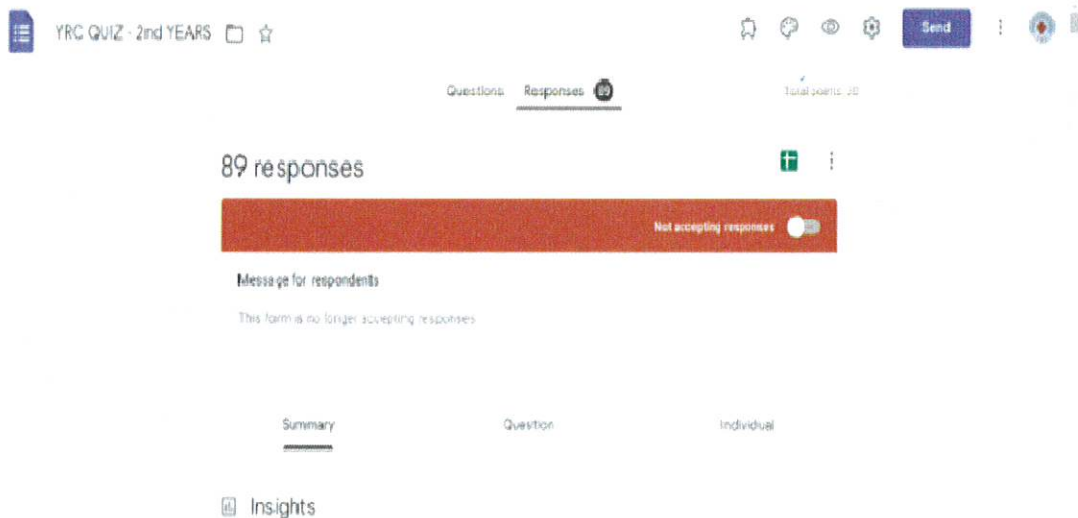
### E-QUIZ

**Date: 19th December 2020**

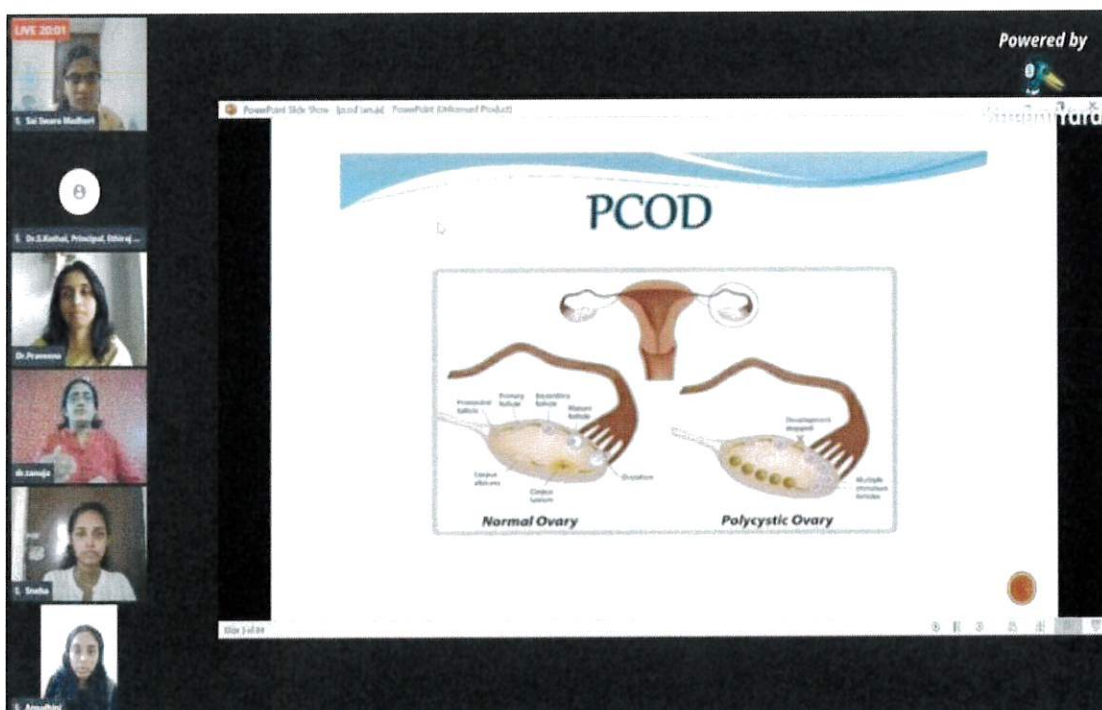
**Number of Participants: 200**
